**All new High-5 and Kindergarten students must submit a choice card for the upcoming school year.**

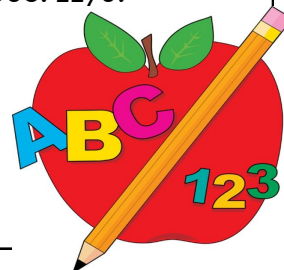
High-5 and Kindergarten registration day will be coming up very soon, please watch out for a scheduled date with Cityview.

The Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCAs) are the state tests in reading, mathematics and science that meet the requirements of the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act. These tests are given every year to measure student performance on the Minnesota Academic Standards, which define what our students should know and do in a particular grade.

✓ **French Immersion at Cityview School.** Why immersion? Early immersion is one of the most effective methods known for acquiring a second language. Students in immersion programs acquire the same proficiency in English and achieve the same levels of competence in their academic subjects as their peers who attend all-English programs. Immersion students acquire advanced levels of functional proficiency in French. They are able to do their schoolwork and communicate with their friends and teachers.
