Why is the flu vaccine important?

• It is THE BEST way to prevent getting the flu!

Who should get the flu shot?

- · People 6 months of age and older.
- Flu shots are safe and recommended for pregnant women and people with chronic conditions.

Who should not get the flu shot?

 Children younger than 6 months old and people who have had an allergic reaction to the flu shot.

Can a flu shot give you the flu?

 Absolutely not! You cannot get the flu from a flu shot.

Do I really need a flu vaccine every year?

 Yes! The CDC recommends a flu shot every year to protect you and your community from influenza!
